<b>SUBJECT</b> Risk Management	<b>TITLE</b> Puck Shooting Machine
<b>Number:</b> 4.6	<b>Approved:</b> March, 2010

<p><b>POLICY</b></p> <p>The puck shooting machine is to be used in a safe and supervised environment.</p>
<p><b>PURPOSE</b></p> <p>The association owns one puck shooting machine which is available for use at the Colchester Legion Stadium.</p>
<p><b>PROCEDURE</b></p> <p>Team personnel (providing they are trained to operate the machine) are responsible for putting the machine and supplementary supplies on the ice at the beginning of each session.</p> <p>The machine and supplementary supplies must be promptly removed from the rink at the end of each session so that the city personnel may begin to flood the ice.</p> <p>The ice machine is available for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Goaltending development clinics</li> <li>• Development team practices\special development camps</li> <li>• Special requests for other situations must be made through the appropriate divisional Rep.</li> </ul> <p>Users must note the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A short orientation is required before using the machine. Please contact the Referee-In- Chief for any and all required instructions and an orientation to the machine.</li> <li>• Any problems with the machine must be reported to the Referee-In-Chief.</li> </ul>
